### **Workshop Report**

A workshop cum training program on 'Dangers of Disaster in Chandrapur and their Management' was held at Janata Mahavidyalaya, Chandrapur [JMV], College Campus on 6th September 2018, by Internal Quality Assurance Cell in collaboration with Disaster Management Cell Collector office Chandrapur.


