A programme on feminine hygiene on 13/09/2014



Achievements of teaching and non-teaching female staff were also celebrated. Program was concluded with tea party.






## **Session 2015-16**


International Women's day celebration: 08/03/2018

more meaningful. More than 30 students participated in the rally along with the teaching staff.










