
Extension Activity at Durgapur

This activity is not about providing solutions to problems, but it was a small effort to show concern and contribute for the welfare of the society. Keeping this view in mind the Women Cell of the college organized this activity at Durgapur (Slum Area). A Lecture series was organized to create awareness in the community about girls safety and to sensitize the community on various issues such as female feticide, infanticide, dowry, sexual harassment, eve-teasing and rape and also enlightened them with the concerning laws and rules for their protection assigned by the constitution of India.

Dr. Margavi Dongre and Dr. Suwarna Mangrulkar from S.P.Law College, Chandrapur explained and discussed all the aspects in detail. Dr. Piyush Ghubade delivered a lecture on the importance of health and hygiene and grabbed the attention of community people. He interacted and discussed about the problems faced by females specially related to bones. Under the guidance of doctor, the college also distributed calcium and vitamin D supplements as per requirements of the people. A survey was also conducted to collect the information of various parameters like domestic violence, female safety, drug abuse, cleanliness etc.

People also used this platform to discuss their problems with Sarpanch and panchayat body. Dr. M.Subhas interacted with the community and thanked the panchayat for their cooperation.

Vice-Sarpanch, members of Panchayat body, Principal of the college, members of women cell and students in large number attended the program. Received a very positive feedback.

More than 50 students participated in the rally along with the teaching staff.







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
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8th March 2019 Celebration of International Women's Day
